Throughout her 30 career in public health and education, she has been an advocate for LGBT equality and sexual health across the lifecycle. Dr. Shyam Seetharaman is an Assistant Professor of Psychology at St. Ambrose University specializing in the field of Behavioral Neuropsychology.
